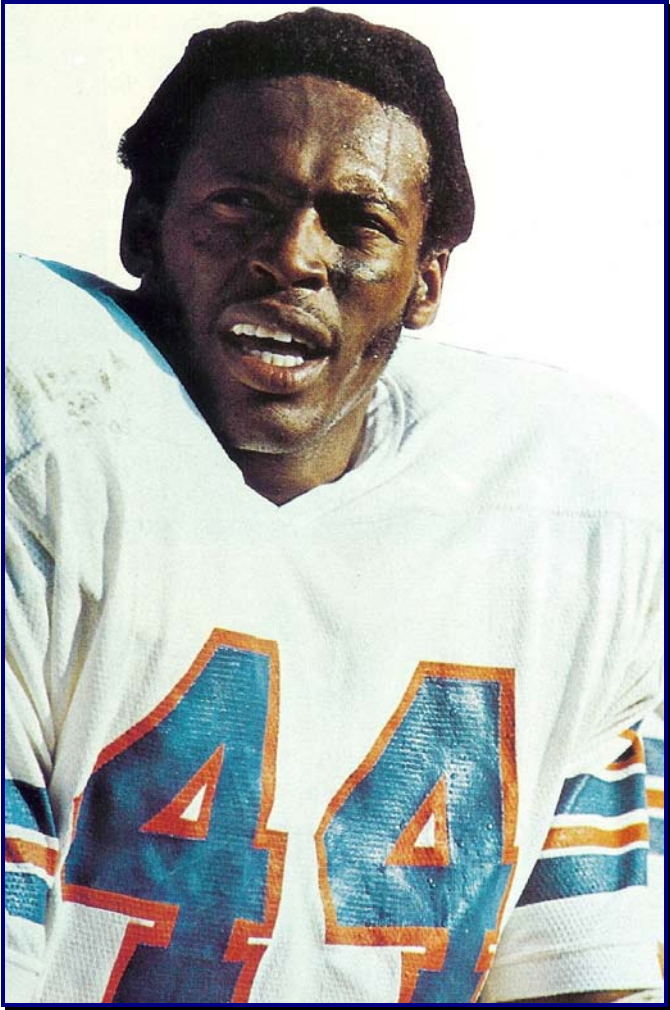


Fig. 71-3. 1971 road jersey detail. Durene materials with vinyl numbering and stripes (F. Little, Dec 19)
